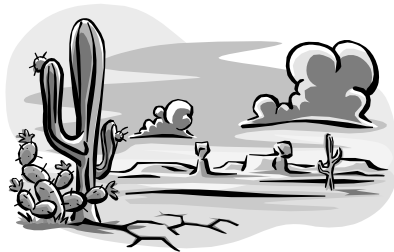

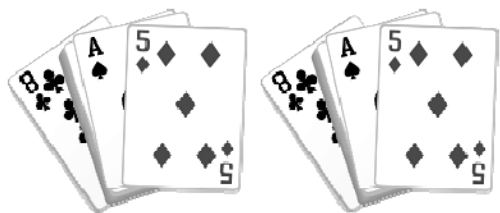

Ending Round Robin Mix-up

Gary Zeiger, Director-in-Charge adds further clarification. "Tables participating in a round robin will be posted on the wall near the director's table. Sometimes they are consecutive table numbers (i.e. A1-A2-A3) and other times they are consecutive table letters (i.e. A1-B1-C1)."

The real key is knowing that you are playing in a round robin.

Behavior Modification Tip*By Jerry Flemming,*

During one of my many trips, I received a suggestion for handling bad behavior at the table that I think is worth passing along. It is passive and non-confrontational, but gets the point across. I like it enough that I plan to use it myself.

It is rather simple. Whenever you encounter bad behavior at the table, such as an opponent or partner berating his/her partner, or giving lessons, or any other behavior that makes you uncomfortable, take your "STOP" card and put it on top of the boards in the center of the table, with the letters pointing in the direction of the offending party. If the behavior does not immediately cease, call the director.

If doing this makes you uncomfortable, ask yourself if putting up with bad behavior, perhaps time and time again, makes you less uncomfortable.

If all of us would do this, and follow up with a director call when necessary, our games would be much more pleasant. Think about it.
